He is been a part of the team at Alchemē Health in Del Mar, California for the past 4 years. Alchemē Health combines integrative health with aesthetics to restore internal and external wellness.

What types of procedures are you using Exovex Exosomes for?

"We primarily use Exovex to treat thinning hair. A typical patient will get 3-6 treatments of the 25B, spaced 1 month apart. We also use Exovex after RF Microneedling procedures to cut down on the swelling and redness."

What have your results been like?

“For hair treatments, Exovex is FAR superior to PRP, which was the gold standard treatment when I started in Cosmetic Dermatology. However, once we saw the results with exosome therapy, we’ve never looked back. In terms of hair density, growth, and thickness, Exovex is clearly more effective than PRP. Plus, it’s more comfortable for the patient, a quicker procedure, with results that are more consistent.”

How to you talk to your patients about exosomes?

“I explain to my patients that exosomes contain 20-25x the amount of growth factors as PRP, so they will achieve superior results with a more comfortable procedure. For facials treatments, I explain how the growth factors in Exovex penetrates the channels created by the procedure, which will stimulate collagen production. We are reintroducing growth factors back into our skin to stimulate our body’s natural healing processes, which we lose as we age.”

What role do you anticipate exosomes will have in regenerative aesthetics in the future?

“Personally, I’m curious to see what role exosomes will play in supporting holistic health with IV therapy. I’m also interested in what role exosomes could play in treating tougher derm cases, like scarring, stretch marks, or non-healing wounds.”

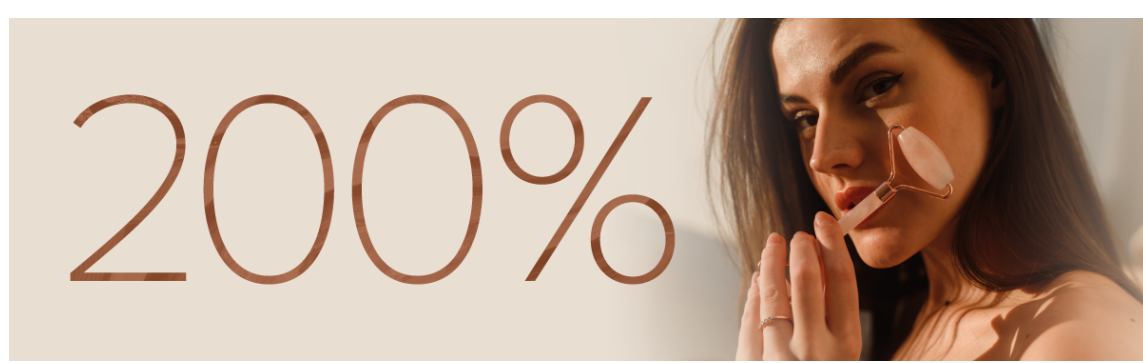
